igap 4 s of February 29, 2020, there are three homes that are Active listed for \$349,000, \$354,000 and \$545,000. Sizes are 1323, 1433, and 2173 square feet built between 1959 and 1963.

One property is Option Pending: 3/2/2 with 1660 square feet list at \$445,000.

Only one property closed during this two-month period. In Section 2 a 3/1.5/2 with 1468 square feet that sold for \$360,000 after being on market for 157 days. The asking was \$275.89 PSF and the sale was \$245.23 PSF

Lazybrook Rentals: There is one for lease as of February 29. Listed for \$1750, built in 1957 with 1220 square feet comprising 2 beds, 1 bath and a 2-car garage. Listed for 36 days

There are two leases pending: One is a 4/2.5/2 listed at \$2,750 and another 4/2/2 listed at \$2,950. Both were on the market for 33 days.

Two others leased: One a 3/1.5/2 with 1221 sq. ft leased for \$2,000 and the other a 3/2/2 with 1405 sq. ft that leased for \$2,400. They were on the market for 137 and 20 days respectively.
