Real Estate Corner

Report Covers: September 1 – October 31, 2019



A s of October 31, 2019, there were two homes that are Active listed at \$414,900 and \$419,900. They are 1,395 square feet and 1,468 square feet -3/2/2 and 3/1.5/2 and have been on the market for 15 and 70 days. The minimum psf asking price is \$286.04 and the maximum psf asking price is \$297.42.

There were two Pending of October 31. Asking prices are \$450,000 to \$725,000. Sizes are 1,610 and 2,828 square feet. A 3/2/2 and 5/3.5/2 with PSF listing prices of from \$256.36 and \$279.50 and have been on the market for 102 and 179 days.

Six properties closed during this period; selling from \$340,000 to \$639,000. In all sales the Seller paid for the Owner's Title Policy. There was one Seller contribution to Buyer's closing costs of \$500.00. These homes range were either 3/2/1 or 3/2/2. Square footage ranged from 1,503 to 2,052. They were on the market between 2 and 141 days.

Lazybrook Rentals:

There are two for lease as of October 31. Listed for \$2,200, built in 1960 with 1,221 square feet - 3 bed, 1.5 bath and 2 car garage and for \$2,400 built in 1955 with 1,568 square feet - 3 bed, 1.5 bath and 1 car garage.

Two properties leased during this period - \$2,000 to \$2,750. Sizes range from 1,779 to 1,855 and were on the market between 9 and 56 days. One was a 3/2/2 and the other a 3/2.5/1.


