## PRESIDENT'S LETTER

Dear Lazybrook,

We are near the end of the ongoing Harris County sponsored road repairs in our neighborhood. After spending a long time advocating for this project, I couldn't be happier with the responsiveness of our partners at Precinct 4 as we have worked through this process over the last 6+ months. As the crews work to finish Lazybrook Dr and tie up loose ends, residents with remaining unresolved issues (damaged sprinklers, missing grass, etc...) should reach out to the County project manager Chris Saldaña (csaldana@hcp4. net) to make sure these items are addressed. As a reminder, please do not contact the City about any issues and do not report these types of reguests via 311---The City of Houston and 311 cannot efficiently route requests to the County.

At our January meeting, 63% of our membership voted to stop mosquito spraying-as per

our bylaws this means mosquito spraying will continue in 2023 (2/3rds majority vote required to pass motion). As a result of the vote, our newly formed mosquito committee has proposed an entirely new program consisting of once-monthly larvicide treatments in all 59 gutter boxes within Lazybrook. This means no more spraying directly on neighbor's properties and this also limits/ eliminates impact on pollinators. This method only costs about half of our previous fogging program, saving us about \$2k/yr. Learn more and bring any feedback on this proposal to our next meeting in March.

I hope everyone is happy with the great work recently completed on our esplanade "Lazybrook" sign landscaping, part of our 2023 planned budget for quarterly regular maintenance of these signs. There will be plenty more to come this year as far as improvements to these areas --- the more membership dues we get, the further we can go!
