## Deed Restrictions Enforcement – Erin Hoffman

- Enforcement Issue at 1830 Locksford Unapproved building materials, unpermitted construction have been sent a letter and reported to the City
- 2411 W. TC Jester New city attorney has committed to progressing enforcement of court order

### Beautification - Kurt Swafford

- May consider a fill in with plantings this fall/winter to replace the drought victims
- Esplanade tree planting capital improvement project TC Jester @ Brooktree/Lazybrook Dr
  - o Approved via vote last meeting, ~\$10,000 project funded 50% by Dist C. and 50% LCC
  - o Grant application submitted, hope to have approval + purchase order from City to start in January
