Introduction/Roll Call & Welcome New Attendees

Special Guests/Presentations

- Harris County Precinct 1 Constable Officer & Team Introduction + Area Crime Discussion
 - Introduction to patrol team leader, shift leaders, and our officer (Deputy Alanis) patrolling the area she will often be located centrally located in the area
 - Patrol service for approx.. 8 hrs/day but outside of those hours other units will respond
 - To get information r.e. the Constable's office, please see their <u>website</u> where you can also sign up for <u>crime alerts</u> and <u>vacation watch</u>.
 - Recommendations based on their patrols thus far:
 - If you will be out of town or away, try to stop package deliveries or have neighbors pick them up
 - People are riding bikes, wearing vests to appear like workers (e.g., Amazon, utilities) to check out neighborhoods and steal packages
 - Call them for any concerns even if you're not sure, it's helpful to have law enforcement presence regularly in the area (but if you have a life-threatening emergency, continue to call 911)
 - Give their number to your alarm company to aid in response; They will be able to help with follow-up information and investigation
 - If you have concerns about suspicious activities happening regularly at a particular residence/area, let them know so they can set up increased patrol/surveillance
 - There have only been 30 calls for service since starting the service 3 arrests made (2 for DWI and 1 for domestic disturbance)
 - Contact information is 713.755.7628 (non-emergency line) and their office is at 7300 N. Shepherd.

Treasurer's Report - Jennifer Ofsowitz & Kurt Swafford

- Review 2023 Balance Sheet Jennifer we took in about \$2700 more dues than we had budgeted and came in under on anticipated expenses (a few things that were not done that we'd planned) resulted in a surplus of about \$15000 that will go towards projects planned for this year
- o 2024 Budget & Plans Kurt
 - Dues to remain the same; it helps when people donate extra to the LCC to fund projects

- Dues go towards 18th St maintenance along the side that borders residents' homes, landscaping, mosquito treatments, etc.
- Tree planting project was approved and work has begun (see below).
- COP signs to be replaced throughout the neighborhood to improve visibility of the program

Deed Restrictions Enforcement - Kurt Swafford

- Multiple complaints about business related traffic at 2423 Lazybrook Dr. there's a rental home being used as a mailing address and place to park commercial vehicles for a business but there does not seem to be an actual business operating there so it is not in violation of our deed restrictions
- Update on 2411 W TC Jester enforcement from city attorney Kurt has emailed the attorney but has not yet had a response

Block Captains – Nicole needs to step down - need to fill Chair of Block Captain – primary responsibility is picking up newsletters from the printer, sorting, and getting to Block Captains.

Beautification – Jessica Swafford

- Our 3 neighborhood signs in nearby esplanades don't have irrigation systems so it has been hard to keep plantings alive will be working on more drought-tolerant ideas
- Esplanade tree planting capital improvement project TC Jester @ Brooktree/Lazybrook Dr Grant application approved! – Project ongoing:
 - Dead trees have been removed waiting for stump grinding and for new trees to be planted
 - City has given us free water for the new plantings so maintenance costs will just be mulching, etc. so, we won't have to pull the irrigation system in a few years as we'd initially planned when approved by membership (thus lowering costs to LCC)
 - Expect 100% completion by March
 - Sandra Puente from Precinct 4 in attendance noted that they have trees available to help with planting that will be compliant with Houston requirements and an arborist to help

Security/COP - Joel DuBois

- 2023 was best year in recent history on COP Hours---Thank you volunteers! 156 hrs total/avg 13 hrs/month
- Most reports online for our area are along 18th St, near businesses and the apartments as opposed to in Lazybrook boundaries
- Make sure to report any concerns to HPD or the Constable's office so that we can track what is happening in the neighborhood

President's Update & SNC-14 Report - Kurt Swafford

- TIRZ 12 Multiple projects/initiatives ongoing that could impact Lazybrook check out the website for information.
 - Preliminary Mobility Plan unveiled recently Trail & Sidewalk Connections, Gaps, etc.
 - Seamist Dr Improvement Project Road Repairs, Underground Detention 11th to Kury Ln. no updates yet
- City of Houston Public Works Design is complete for Traffic Management plan on Ella near Sinclair ES Kurt attended a meeting earlier today about this. It's a plan for a reduced traffic lane on Grovewood at Ella to help with safer crossings for pedestrians:
 - Help reduce speed rate
 - Reduce crossing distance
 - Provide median refuge
 - District C is funding this out of their discretionary funds one week left for public comments engage@houstontx.gov
